

Homework	Set on Class Dojo every Friday:
	Spellings: Weekly spellings will consist of a list of 10 words with the Year 3/4 statutory spellings list.
	<ul> <li>Weekly Spelling Tests will take place on Fridays.</li> <li>Please make sure your child is practising their spellings as much as possible.</li> </ul>
	Spellings are passed onto children every Monday for the children to practice at home. I know the children work really hard on these throughout the work so any practice at home would be ever so beneficial.
	Maths: IXL activities linking to our classroom learning.  TTRS multiplication sums will also be available for the children to access at home if they wish. As a class, we a have been practising our timetables each day, asking random timetable questions as the children come into school as well as doing small tests as a class.  Despite the multiplication check won't be happening till later on in June, the more practice the better the children will become. Constant practice doing it as much as you can.
	Reading: Children will be asked to take home their AR books home from school daily. You should try to at least read with your child for at least 5 minutes. They can then quiz on these in school on 'Accelerated Reader'.
