Literacy: Reading - please continue to read AR books and phonic books coming home (15minutes a day).  Maths:I will add new learning on IXL.
	Reading for Pleasure	We will continue to read our books from the library about journeys and adventures. We have some double copies so the children have enjoyed pairing up and reading the same book together.
RO	Reading	We now use Talk Through Stories where the children have a book a week to listen, enjoy and use the VIPERS skills in different activities. They really are enjoying this scheme as they know what the focus is on each day.
	Writing	We will be starting the term with a short burst of recount writing. This will be about their half term and the theatre trip. We will then start a sequence on 'Traction Man' which is a great text and will engage all the children. I will pop on Dojo what I would like the children to do as a hook for this sequence.
2+3=5	Maths	I have looked at what the children need to strengthen their year 2 skills and any gaps and have seen we need to look at more division and fraction work. We will keep practising basic skills and number facts too.
	RE	We are using the Come and See programme and our topic is 'Reconciliation - 'Rules" where the children will make the link with the rules in everyday life and rules to live by which make us good people.
