The year 1's have been helping with the actions and the year 2's have been building on this and mapping for themselves. We will continue our sequence which will finish with the children writing a sentence (or more) about an animal that came to their house for tea! | |

| 2+3=5 | Maths | This term we will be looking at place value. Year ones will be securing their number understanding to 10 and beyond. Year 2 will know the position of the digit in a number tells us the value of the digit. For example, in '25', they will understand that the first number (2) shows the number of tens, and the second number (5) shows the number of ones. The beauty of a mixed class is the children will be accessing what they are capable of and also be challenged. | |
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| | RE | We are using the Come and See programme and our topic is creation. We will be looking at our own families and how God fits into our family too. | |
| | Science | This term we are going to be looking at seasons, making predictions and measuring rainfall. | |
