An ecumenical service is being held on **Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> November at 3pm, at Holy Family Church in Plymouth** (Beacon Park Road, Plymouth, PL2 3LR). The service is being held in response to the 16 days of action against gender-based violence (25<sup>th</sup> November – 10<sup>th</sup> December), which is a campaign for the prevention and elimination of violence against women and girls. The service will be led by Fr Mark Skelton and Rev. Lizzi Green. Following the service there will be tea and coffee in the hall.

### ANGEL TREE AND OPERATION ELF <https://prisonfellowship.org.uk/our-work/angel-tree/>

**Why do we do it?** There are around 312,000 children in England and Wales with a parent in prison (Estimate taken from 2019 Crest Advisory *Children of Prisoners* report). That means, more than double the number of children are affected by parental imprisonment than divorce in the family. 7% of all children (around 1 in 15) will experience their father's imprisonment before they leave school.

Angel Tree is a very simple and incredibly rewarding way to help prisoners stay in contact with their families during imprisonment, which can contribute to reducing re-offending rates. Those prisoners being visited by a partner or family member have a 52% re-offending rate as compared to 70% for those who do not.\*
